OVERVIEW

We are looking for a Worship Director to lead the music ministry for Sunday services and church events. The ideal candidate has significant experience leading worship from the stage, as well as experience managing volunteers. Story Church exists to know, live and share the one true story and this position will contribute to the overall mission and vision of the church. It's our vision to disciple believers through biblical teaching and theologically informed worship. We are a rapidly growing church and are looking for someone to develop and expand our worship ministry coming out of a covid world. This role requires a person who relates well with people of different ages and backgrounds and can manage complex, growing systems and structures on a church-wide scale.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Champion a vibrant music ministry vision that moves people to worship God.
- Lead worship for Sunday services, prayer nights and other regular worship services
- Provide leadership to the worship team
 - Instruct band members on what parts to learn for rehearsal
 - Provide guidance and coaching during rehearsals to pursue and achieve musical excellence
 - Guide the band through pre-service run through
- In consultation with your supervisor, define a worship team pipeline that contributes to the church's overall vision. Recruit, develop, and deploy worship ministry volunteers.
- Regularly report to the church's leadership about the accomplishments of the worship ministry.
- Maintain the integrity of God's word by ensuring that our worship ministry is consistent with the doctrinal convictions of the church.
- Oversee and manage administrative duties including email, calendaring, church software systems, and scheduling and executing events.

REQUIREMENTS

- A bachelor's degree (preferably in Worship or Christian ministry).
- A willingness to become a member at Story Church.
- Agree with Story Church's Statement of Faith and commit to exhibit a lifestyle that is consistent with the same.
- Proficient with Apple products and software, Microsoft Office Suite, Google Platform, and other programs and software used by the Church.
- Two years of experience leading and serving in church worship ministry.
- A desire to teach and mentor children in biblical truth.
- A growing Christian faith and character.
- Ability to pass a background check.
- Ability to navigate the assimilation of worship volunteers, including rehearsals and having complex conversations.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Understanding of and willingness to serve within the doctrinal commitments of the church.
- A commitment to the mission and vision of the church.
- A demonstrated call to vocational ministry.
- A lifestyle congruent with the biblical requirements for leaders (1 Tim. 3:1-13; 2 Tim. 2; Titus 1:5-9).
