Overview:

Kaleo Church desires to make much of Jesus in Anchorage, Alaska. Anchorage is the most populous city in Alaska with over forty percent of the state's population (close to 300,000). Anchorage is a diverse city with over 90 languages represented in our school district, and contains 3 of the 10 most diverse neighborhoods in the US. Our hope is that Kaleo is as diverse as our city, together making disciples who make disciples, tangibly building hope in our city, and planting new churches in the Anchorage area and beyond. We are looking for the next Worship Arts Director to join the elder and staff teams to lead the church in worship, arts, and liturgy.

Role Summary:

The Worship Arts Director is responsible for leading, managing, and developing a team of volunteers to include musicians, singers, and audio-visual technicians that will lead Kaleo Church in worship during our Sunday morning service.

Qualifications:

- Fulfills the character qualifications of a deacon as taught in the Scriptures (1 Tim 3:8-13)
- An understanding of the gospel message and mission, with the ability to articulate their personal redemption story.
- Ability to lead Kaleo Church in song both vocally and instrumentally.
- Ability to lead a band.
- Ability to lead, develop, manage, and recruit a diverse group of volunteers.
- Experience with AV equipment and ability to train AV personnel.
- Experience with Office software (Excel, Word, Outlook, Teams, etc.), church software (Planning Center Online, Pastor's Line, CCLI, Song Select, Proclaim, Church Plant Media, etc.) and graphic/video editing software (Vimeo, Canva, Facebook, etc.).

- Attendance and participation in weekly staff meetings.
- Participation in personal, spiritual, and professional development.
- Flexibility in scheduling to grow and develop leaders.
