- Serve as the primary leader, teacher, and communicator.

- Develop a strategy for reaching students in their regular environments (school lunches, athletic events, school plays, FCA, etc.).
- Provide resources, biblical tools, and weekly communication for parents to intentionally disciple their student.
- Serve as the primary pastor to all students and their families.

- Serve as the primary pastor for college ministry.

Pastoral Responsibilities

- Work with Lead Pastor (& pastors) to develop yearly Sermon Series Calendar.
- Be ready and available to preach in Sunday services 2-3 times a year.
- Be available to assist Lead Pastor in counseling, ministering, and leading.
- Occasionally officiate premarital counseling, weddings, and funerals as needed.
- Set an example as an overseer/shepherd in caring for our people.
